11 (l) the assets of the Corporation shall be vested in The United Church of Canada in the event that the Corporation ceases to function or its corporate existence is terminated

Replace with: Upon the dissolution of the corporation and after payment of all debts and liabilities, its remaining property shall be distributed or disposed of to the United Church of Canada if at that time the United Church of Canada is a qualified donee within Newfoundland and Labrador as described in subsection 149.j(1) of the Income Tax Act or if not, the remaining property shall be distributed to another qualified donee within Newfoundland and Labrador, as described in subsection 149.J (1) of the Income Tax Act
