

If you are interested in participating, St. James United Church has invited Gower St UC and Cochrane St UC to join them. Below is the route that will be taken:

- Heading northeast on New Gower St toward Duckworth St (80m)
- Slight right onto Duckworth St (1.28km)
- Turn left onto Cavendish Square (73m)
- Slight left onto Military Rd (382m)
- Turn right onto Bannerman Rd (114m) then left into the park
