

REVISED NOTICE OF MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS

Cochrane Community Outreach and Performance Centre Inc.
January 28th, 2024 and February 4th, 2024

On Sunday, January 28, 2024, immediately following the morning worship service, a special meeting of the members of Cochrane Community Outreach and Performance Centre Inc. (CCOPC) will be held in the event space at Cochrane Centre. As of December 2023, the five-year management agreement between Cochrane Community Outreach and Performance Centre Inc. and First Light has officially ended. The CCOPC Board of Directors has received and unanimously moved to support an ownership proposal from First Light. First Light's proposal will be presented to the CCOPC membership at this special meeting by Breannah Flynn, Director of Business Operations for First Light, ***followed by a Q & A session and opportunity for discussion.*** It should be noted that the Cochrane Street United Church congregation's continuing access to worship in the building would be guaranteed by First Light.

The second membership meeting to be held on Sunday, February 4th, will provide an additional Q and A opportunity, after which a motion to support First Light's proposal will be presented to the membership for a vote.
