

NOTES FROM THE ARCHIVES

Many people assisted in fighting the fire which destroyed the church, (Jan 18, 1914) including the fire department, the constabulary, and naval reservists, under the command of Lieutenant Commander Atlay, Captain of HM Training Ship "Calypso", who sent 40 men to the scene under the command of Gunnery Instructor Sangwell.
