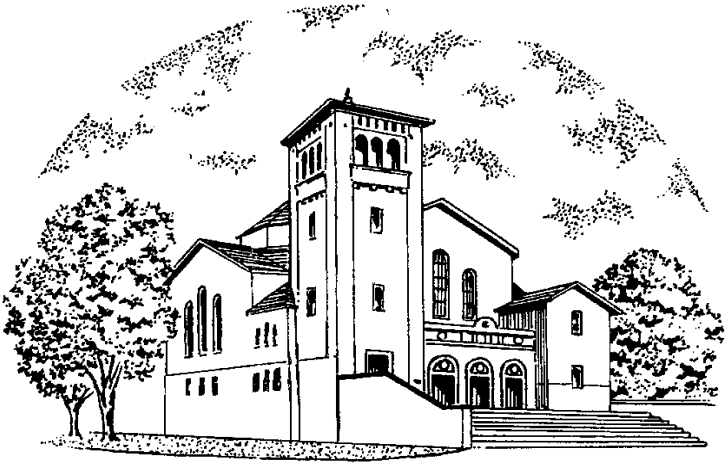

Kindred Works has been established by the United Church of Canada to provide a way to repurpose church properties to respond to Canada's housing crisis and community needs.
