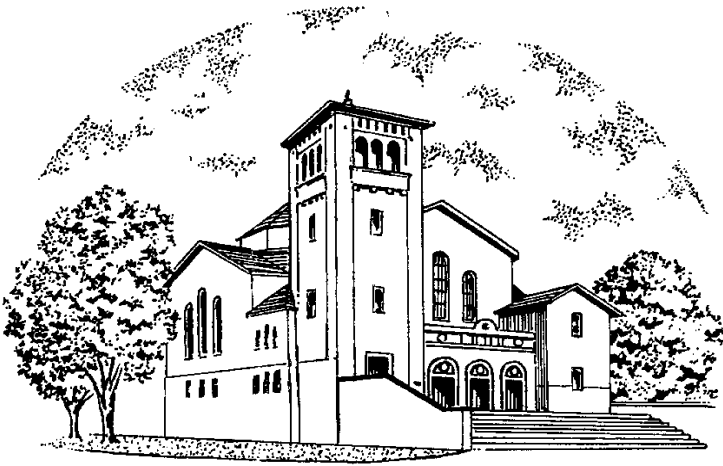

NOTES FROM THE ARCHIVES

A NEW BEGINNING! Second of 9 Parts

A. J. Carman Paine was the son of the church's former minister, Rev. George Paine. He was an architect in Montreal at this time and was the church's contact with the architectural firm of Ross and MacDonald. It was felt that because the congregation was non-conformist, that is, Protestant but not Church of England, the building's architecture should fit more with the form of worship where everyone was in easy reach of the minister in an auditorium type of setting.
