We have reached our target of \$1,000 for the cemetery fund. Thanks again to all who have donated. We have already sent a cheque to Bridges to Hope for \$1,090 that covered donations received up to the end of September. Some of you have sent in additional donations this fall and we will be sending another cheque to Bridges to Hope later in December if any of you would like to contribute more. So far this year we have sent \$4,020 to M & S which covered our donations up to the end of August. We will be sending another cheque later in December to cover the donations that we have received since then, so there is still time for you to get your donation to us. We are also still on target to meet our annual goal of \$18,000 (\$1,500 monthly) to Cochrane Centre. Your monthly contributions either through PAR or in our Cochrane Centre envelopes helps us immensely to meet this commitment.

Our music ministry will once again be highlighted during this coming Advent season. This year we are pleased to have the choral scholars join the choir. We have a full program of services planned for you. Visit the church's website for information on Christmas on Cochrane Street and this year's Christmas theme, The Inn: Housing the Holy. I hope you enjoy these ministries and that they both provide you with a feeling of hope as we journey through the advent season together.
